The 2025 Manitowoc County Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep programs has been **rescheduled** for **Saturday**, **October 11** for households and Friday, October 10 for farms and qualifying businesses.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. This change is being made due to the Memorial Drive detour to HWY 310, the increased traffic on HWY 310, and out of an abundance of caution for any program participants as well as the general public travelling on HWY 310.

The Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep accepts items including pesticides, cleaning products, oil and lead based paints, automotive chemicals and mercury. Many of these common items are hazardous when used, stored or disposed of improperly. Look for items that contain the following warnings on their labels: **Danger**, **Warning**, **Caution**, **Poison**, **Combustible**, **Flammable**, **Corrosive**, and **Toxic**. <u>Latex</u> paints will NOT be accepted at Clean Sweep.

Residents and farms can dispose of hazardous chemicals for free. Qualifying businesses may be eligible for subsidized disposal rates. Businesses and farms must pre-register by calling 683-4333 by October 3.
