Special Meeting of the Town Board

A special meeting of the Mishicot Town Board was held at the Town Hall, 710 N. State St., Mishicot, on Monday, July 14, 2025 at 5:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairperson Anhalt called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. In attendance for the board were Dean Anhalt, Lee Stefaniak, Gordon Augustine, Tammy Thielbar, and Connie Tesarik.

CLOSED SESSION TO DISCUSS APPLICANTS UNDER WIS. STATUTES 19.85(1)(c)

At 5:32 p.m. Chairperson Anhalt called for a motion to go into closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of discussing the candidates interviewed for the Road Superintendent vacancy and to create a job proposal. Supervisor Stefaniak moved to go into closed session. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Augustine. All votes were in favor. Motion carried. Roll Call Vote: Anhalt, Stefaniak, and Augustine – Ayes 3, Nays 0. Treasurer Thielbar and Clerk Tesarik were present.

The board considered the requests made by the two applicants for wages and benefits, their skills and their qualifications.

RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION UNDER WIS. STATUTES 19.85(2)

At 6:12 p.m. Chairperson Anhalt called for a motion to reconvene in open session pursuant to Sections 19.83 and 19.85(2) of Wisconsin Statutes. Supervisor Stefaniak moved to reconvene in open session. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Augustine. All votes were in favor. Motion carried. Roll Call Vote: Anhalt, Stefaniak, and Augustine – Ayes 3, Nays - 0. Treasurer Thielbar and Clerk Tesarik were present.

JOB OFFER

Supervisor Stefaniak moved to present Cory Augustine with a job offer with the things listed here and open to negotiation with the board: Wage of \$29.50; four weeks of vacation; ten-hour days until November 1; a health insurance stipend of 50 cents per hour [if no health insurance is needed]. Motion seconded by Chairman Anhalt. Stefaniak and Anhalt - Ayes 2; Supervisor Augustine - Abstain. Motion carried.

Supervisor Stefaniak moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:36 p.m. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Augustine. All votes were in favor. Motion carried.
